It can be present as highpitched, nasal and midranged, low and humming or via a heap of other ways. What we mean when we say “noise” is almost always in relation to something undesirable. We don’t mean the experimental musical style, also called “noise”. Some of that stuff is great. Noise in this instance is the audio we can hear that we don’t want in our overall sound. Noise in the guitar world is usually the result of electromagnetic interference EMI which is all around us in the modern world. This EMI interacts with many guitar cables, pickups, amplifiers and other electronic equipment and when fed into a guitar amplifier particularly amps with high preamp gain, can produce a lot of unwanted noise. Sometimes noise can even stem from maintenance issues such as cables, dirty pots and jacks on pedals and other gear, damaged amplifiers, poorly wound and installed pickups or other guitar electronics to name but a few common causes. As every player and their setup is different, noise can come from many different sources. The best way to avoid noise is to use quality equipment, look after it and have it serviced. But that’s often easier said than done. Simply put, you know when noise is present and you definitely want it gone. The solution is to incorporate some sort of tool to defeat the interference. For many players, that solution is the BOSS NS2 Noise Suppressor. Used by everyone from bedroom players to international touring bands like Metallica, Slipknot, U2 and The Dillinger Escape Plan among many others, the BOSS NS2 is an industry standard in noise suppression. Its innovative design is as effective today as it was at the time of its release. Whether you are looking to minimise unwanted noise in your rig, or perhaps even use it as a tonetool for sculpting aggressive rhythm guitar textures, depends on how you connect it to your rig, and understanding just how it works. GETTING CONNECTED At first glance, you’ll see the NS2 has 4 jacks. These jacks allow the NS2 to be configured in 2 different ways, depending on your rig and your desired outcome. For the purposes of this article, we’ll refer to these two different configurations as the SIMPLE method and the ADVANCED method. SIMPLE METHOD This is the simplest way to use the NS2. Simply insert the NS2 into your signal chain as the last item AFTER your noisy pedals or amp. The limitation with the Simple method is that at high noise levels common with high gain pedals and amps, the Noise Suppressor has difficulty in determining what is noise and what is your actual guitar signal. This can manifest a problem when playing long sustained notes with high preamp gain. As the note starts to die out, the Noise Suppressor in Simple mode may end up “clamping down” and cutting the end of the note off. This effect can actually be

desirable for some players. Guitarists who play highgain, staccato rhythms often relish the “choppy” effect that the Simple Method can deliver.<http://myplumbingwebsite.com/userfiles/cuisinart-automatic-grind-and-brew-manual-10-cup.xml>

If you are looking to use a Noise Suppressor to “tighten up” your high gain rhythms, then the Simple connection method may be best for you. To combat this problem, the NS2 was designed with an intelligent “detection circuit” designed to differentiate between your guitar signal and unwanted noise. To take advantage of this functionality, we can connect using the ADVANCED method. When correctly connected using this method, the NS2 will “detect” your guitar’s signal and allow the noise suppression circuit to activate only as your guitar signal dies out, resulting in a more natural guitar sound. The NS2 was the first pedal to achieve this style of noise suppression and remains an industry standard still today. Once you have the pedal connected in either method, the NS2 becomes an invaluable tool. The key to optimum results, is understanding just what the main control knobs do. NS2 CONTROLS The THRESHOLD control sets how sensitive you wish the Noise Suppressor to be, i.e. the “threshold” at which the Noise Suppression begins to do its work. Setting the THRESHOLD all the way to MAX will cut nearly anything, including guitar signal. If you want to back it off a bit, you’ll also be able to still get nice feedback swells if you desire. A bit of breathing room here can be good. The DECAY control allows you to set to how fast or slow you want the signal to fade out when the suppression circuitry kicks in. Slower DECAY settings will give a more natural overall guitar sound, and avoid the end of long notes being “chopped off” as they die out. Faster DECAY settings are favoured amongst many metal guitarists for the way in which it creates a “choppy” sound that suits tight, high gain rhythm playing. The MODE SELECTOR knob offers options for different ways to utilise the NS2. In REDUCTION mode, the NS2 will suppress unwanted noise, as determined by the Threshold. To activate Reduction mode, simply select it via the Mode Selector and press the pedal ON.

If the pedal is not switched on in Mute mode, the pedal will work the same as it would in Reduction mode. Essentially, Mute mode does not have a bypass feature. It will reduce your noise but will kill all sound when you step on the pedal. WHAT ABOUT EFFECTS Ok, good question. You can absolutely use effects and other pedals with the NS2! However. Keep in mind that the NS2 has a DECAY feature. Best way to use reverb and delay effects with the NS2 is to put them AFTER it does its work. You can also put modulation pedals here if you want too. We’ve discussed using overdrive pedals with the NS2 earlier in this article. But, if you’re using the 4cable or “Xmethod”, the only pedal you should plug into before the NS2 is your tuner. Whichever setup you choose, the BOSS NS2 Noise Suppressor will clean up your overall sound while maintaining the dynamics and nuances of your playing. Chrisz, 11.02.2015 Its very easy to use there are only 3 knobs on it, threshold determines the sound level the signal needs to fall below before the NS2 silences it, decay determinies the time before the effect kicks in the further clockwise you turn it, the more natural it sounds, but it will be less efficient at cutting noise. You can pretty much leave this at minimum, unless it sounds unnatural to your ears and mode. There are two modes reduction, which means when the pedal is off, nothing is happening, and when the pedal is on, it cuts noise; and mute, which cuts noise when the pedal is off, and totally mutes your sound e.g. for tuning when the pedal is on. Theres also a handy led to tell you when it is actually cutting noise. It has a sendreturn circuit for plugging your other pedals into. The NS2 completely rids it of any noise that I dont want. When you start playing a note, its instantaneously there. Theres no annoying fade in that leaves the attack sounding like something fluffy and uncertain. When I dont play even with the distortion on and turned up all the way its virtually silent.

It has a mute option that allows you to simply cut all sound from the guitar instantly. So if you begin to get feedback, step on it and it will be gone. If you are deciding what noise removing thing to buy, this is it. It cleans up my signal considerably, without any noticeable degradation of tone. I have a couple of noisy single coil pickup guitars and the improvement when using the NS2 is dramatic. The pedal itself is typical of the Boss tradition, in that its well built with a simple layout. The inclusion of a 9 volt in and out socket on the rear is very handy. It allows me to run an extra pedal from time to time without the need for another power supply. It has a couple of features that, to be honest, I just dont use. Theres a loop feature that allows you to run noisy pedals through the gate circuit while allowing your guitar signal straight through unaffected. Theres also a mute mode that allows you to cut the entire signal. handy for some on stage situations. I just run it on my pedal board after my compression and overdrives and before my delay and reverb. Its a simple setup that works well. I have absolutely no complaints. The controls are very straightforward. A minute or two playing around with the NS2 and youll have the hang of it. I demoed several other units, but found that the Boss ticked all the boxes. Keep in mind when you set the settings that high, you will lose some things like sustain etc. But the decay is very natural sounding though. I had to find the happy medium sweet spot for my liking between full gain and clean channels. I run a Mesa Boogie tube head, I have a ton of rack gear, pedals etc. All are isolated through a high end monster power conditioner and I still will get noise at high volumes even on clean, so this pedal made all the difference for me. Its one of the best Ive ever tried. Most are so unnatural sounding that they are not worth using at all, you are

better off just using a volume pedal. With this pedal, you cant go wrong. Buy it. It is now one of my top 3 favorite pedals. It is an outstanding product, provided that you connect it with your other devices correctly and dial it in properly. There is an article on Rolands site that gives several different scenarios of how to hook up the pedal in line with your other pedals and amp. However this thing is darn near perfect. It pulled all the noise out of my effects pedals, leaving almost pure silence when I am not playing. I did not notice any negative effects on the sound. Awesome pedal. My guitarists amp had crazy feedback until I got this pedal. Now we dont hate him anymore. Gets heavy use, always on and rockin'. Use primarily TC boxes and this mates well in the drive chain. Will keep your products in mind for future purchases. Highly recommend I almost need two of these so I can swap settings on the fly.
