I just purchase a 25 hp Yamaha and have all the paper work for it as well. Good info so far. Close to a deal breaker. I bought a new from the dealer Montauk in 1986 and cannot say for sure that I passed the book work on to the next lucky fellow. Must be the loose Florida life style. Thanksfully they are always unlocked. I let one of them go with a sale, but had to hang on to one as a keepsake. By the way, I tested the prop you sent me on Thanksgiving day and it works well with the 60 Evinrude on my 15 classic. Thanks again, Keith None have come with engine manuals. Each of the boats I have pruchased have been in excellent shape and the materials handed to me upon pruchase proved the loveing way each boat was treated. PS I am doing my best to continue the tradition, I still have 3 of the boats. John L. Only 2 of those 4 that had owners manuals for the hull also had the manuals for the motor as well. That said my when I bought my 1976 Newport with its 1974 Evinrude Starflite 85hp motor in December of 2007 the vessel came with a complete owners manual, original wood location drawings and packing list from Whaler. Also, the motor had its original owners manual, bill of sale from its purchase, warranty documents, warranty registration card looks like an Evinrude Credit Card, dealer checklist and a complete hand written diary of the entire motors use and service history. I still use the diary to log service and hours on the motor. I added up the hours last year and though I did not remember the exact number it was well under 250. Though all these documents really do not add to the value they are still neat to have. BTW NONE of the Whalers where ever missing a key for the consoles or other lockers, motors or trailer. The only documentation it did not come with was the service manual for the engine, and the purchase date of the Group 24 Marine Battery. But it did have the engine manual for the 2000 Mercury.

My 1979 Montauk came with nothing except for the photocopied Mills canvas installation diagrams. My 1989 Outrage 22 Cuddy came with the original Whaler owners manual, the vinyl pouch well worn, the original Mercury owners manual for the 200 and one for the 15. Also included were factory shop manuals for the 200 and for the 15. In addition, there was a manual for the Loran, one for the CRT depth sounder and one for the vintage color Garmin GPS. Missing was the owners manual for the VHF radio, but I was able to download a copy from the internet. The one for the 120 Evinrudes is the factory manual and takes a 3 inch binder to hold it. Jeff If anyone needs or wants copies please email. Mel They were all passed on to the guy who bought it from me. My 2004 13 Sport came with nothing. The 1976 boat and motor came without owners manuals. The 1987 boat came with outboard owners manuals, but not a Boston Whaler boat manual that I can recall. The 1990 boat came with owners manuals for the boat and 1992 motor.
